Proof of Compliance Required for LLM Graduates of ABA Approved Law Schools:

Applicants qualifying to sit for the bar examination under Section 520.3 must file with the Board a completed Certificate of Law School Attendance Form, and Official final transcripts, **no later than June 15, 2022 for the July 2022 exam.**
