**Application Filing Period: April 1 – 30, 2022.** THERE IS NO PROVISION FOR LATE FILING.

Examination Dates - **Tuesday, July 26 and Wednesday, July 27 2022**

### New York Certificate of Attendance

The form is created electronically when you register for the exam and the form is sent directly to the Law School to verify the information and certify the degree. If there are errors this office will correct them. JDs do not need to submit a “paper” certificate for New York.

### Specimen of Applicants Handwriting:

The sample for New York will be completed when you arrive to take your exam. If your state requires this form please contact Melody Padgett in the Law School Registrar’s office to complete this form with you.

### OTHER JURISDICTIONS

State bar authorities require certification of Law School attendance/graduation. Many states require the certification on a specific form; others accept the certification on Law School letterhead. It is your responsibility to obtain any necessary documents, and submit them to the Law School Registrar’s Office with instructions for:

- (a) When they must be submitted, and
- (b) Where they must be sent.
