

## International Court of Justice Fellowship

Due Date to Cornell Law School: **December 14<sup>th</sup> 2025**

### Eligibility:

This fellowship is open to JD, LLM, and JS students graduating in May 2026, as well as prior JD and LLM and JS students. To be eligible, candidates should be 31 years of age or younger at the time the program begins. This requirement may be waived only in special circumstances. In making its selection, the Court seeks candidates of diverse nationalities. Applicants must have excellent proficiency in one of the Court's official languages (French or English) and a very good working knowledge of the other is considered an asset. Candidates must demonstrate excellent results in their legal studies, and an interest in public international law through their studies, publications and/or work experience.

### Application Details

The following documents are required:

1. Application form and summary table, to be filled in by the candidate. (links below)
2. Two or three letters of reference.
3. Official academic record of the candidate.
4. A writing sample of no more than 15 pages.
5. This is a two step process - First you must earn an endorsement from the Review Committee here at the Law School and they will then submit endorsed candidates to the Fellowship Program for consideration.
